

BEHAVIOUR CONSEQUENCE FLOWCHART

RATIONALE

The below behaviours are examples of what can be expected at the each level. This list is not exhaustive and when considering what action to take it is important to consider the intent of the student and the context of the behaviours. Steps may be skipped when behaviour escalates rapidly or if safety is a concern.

Level 3 Continued behaviours from above → Refusing to complete set work Class Time Out Inappropriate physical contact * (May be at a higher level, **Class Teacher** depend on circumstance) Level 4 Continued behaviours from above **Buddy Class** → Leaving the room without permission → Arguing/speaking back to teacher **Class Teacher** Continued behaviours from above with the addition of: Level 5 This level requires → Students leaving class/running parent contact but Office Time Out off without permission and not this may occur at returning Class any level above. → Refusing to follow instructions Teacher / (after warning (s) → Unsafe behaviours that puts others in danger Leadership → Intentional swearing Bullying (refer to Bullying and Harassment Guidelines) Continued behaviours from above with the addition of; → Stealing peers' belongings Level 5 → Showing other students inappropriate material **Take Home** (pornographic images) → Swearing directly at teacher Leadership → Personal insults at staff Intentional and directed swearing Level 7 Continued behaviours from above with the addition of: → Violence Suspension → Influence of alcohol and/or drugs at school Seriously damaging school property Leadership
